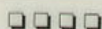

The Washtenaw Development Council recognized **Web Elite** as one of the fastest growing technology companies in Washtenaw County. The WDC awarded Web Elite its prestigious FastTrack Award. The Washtenaw region serves as a center for technology-focused companies.

Also, the Interactive Association of Michigan (GLIMA) awarded Web Elite two honors at the Third Annual GlimAwards.
