## Special Olympics gets Web site

This year, former U of M football coach Bo Schembechler played to help raise money.

At the July 30 event, \$55,000 was raised.

While the fund-raiser does invite well-known football icons, the organization wants the focus to remain on the children.

"It is their day and their fundraiser," Leoni said in a press release. "We are here for the kids."

Washtenaw County Special Olympics is a year round, community based sports training and competition program for children and adults with mental retardation.

Competitors must be at least 8 years old. Children between 5

and 8 years old are allowed to train for Special Olympics sports.

Washtenaw County Special Olympics has more than 400 athletes participating in its programs. The organization receives no state or federal funding, but relies solely on contributions of time, material and financing from individuals, businesses and organizations throughout the country.

With 18,000 athletes, Michigan has one of the largest and highest quality programs in the nation.
